ITINERARY

HOW TO REACH THE GRAND PRINCE HOTEL OSAKA BAY:

Kansai International Airport

Limousine Airport Bus:

The airport limousine bus to the hotel departs from Bus Stop 7 of terminal 2 and Bus Stop 3 of terminal 1. Take the bus bound for Osaka Nanko for JPY1,600 per person. (Travel time: 50 minutes.)

Taxi:

A direct taxi ride from the airport to the Hotel would cost approximately JPY14,000 per car (4 persons maximum). The travel time is approximately 45 minutes depending on traffic. Note: this is the most convenient way to reach the Hotel outside the operating hours of the limousine bus service.

Hotel limousine car:

Hotel limousine takes approximately 45 minutes depending on traffic and costs JPY22,000 per car per trip. Advance reservation is necessary.

Train:

Take a Limited Express Haruka to JR Osaka station. From there catch the Hotel's complimentary shuttle bus service OR a taxi. Travel time is approximately 25 minutes and the cost is approximately JPY7,000 per car (4 persons maximum).

Itami Domestic Airport

Taxi:

The most convenient way to reach the Hotel is via a taxi. The journey takes approximately 35 minutes at a cost of JPY8,000 per car (4 persons maximum).

A big advantage of this arrangement is that your luggage will be in your room or the hotel's secure room when you check into the hotel, thus making for a smoother check in (where available). If you need anything during the day- medication, umbrella, water, food, rain jacket, jumper, camera, etc- make sure you keep them in a day bag.

DAY 2

SUNDAY 5 NOVEMBER 2023

HIROSHIMA

Breakfast

Wendy will let you know what time you need to bring your luggage down to the lobby for collection.

Please meet in the hotel lobby ready to depart at 8.00am.

The tour begins this morning with a transfer to Osaka Train Station for a high speed Shinkasen train to Hiroshima. Our luggage will be transferred by truck.

Lunch will not be available to purchase on the train, so please purchase something at Osaka station.

On arrival, we will explore some of Hiroshima's fascinating contemporary buildings including the Museum of Art (Kisho Kurokawa), and the Simose Art Museum Otake.

This afternoon we will take the ferry across to Miyajima Island and visit the Itsukushima Shrine at sunset with our local guide.

We then check into our hotel.

This morning we visit the Peace Memorial Park and Museum. Afterwards we travel to Fukuyama for a photo stop at the Ribbon Chapel.

After lunch, we continue to Kurashiki where we will visit the gardens at the Kohtei Pavilion then a traditional house in Ohashi. This is a 1796 Kurashiki merchant's house with unique architectural features- notably the gate, the wall, windows, and lattice. It has been designated as a nationally important cultural asset.

Chichu Art Museum has paintings from Monet's "Water Lilies" series. Benesse House Museum shows contemporary sculpture. We also have a photo stop at the Yellow Pumpkin Sculpture (Yayoi Kusama).

We return to our hotel late afternoon.

This morning we travel to Hyogo Prefectural Museum of Art – Ando Gallery. After lunch, we will visit the Tazaemon Yamamura House (Yodoko Guest House), the first of two Frank Lloyd Wright buildings we will see in Japan. We then transfer to the Chapel of the Wind.

We check into our hotel late afternoon. Kobe is the capital of Hyogo Prefecture and one of Japan's ten largest cities. Located between the sea and the Rokko mountain range, Kobe is also considered one of Japan's most attractive cities.

Ando designed the Koshino House for fashion designer Hiroko Koshino and her family during 1979 - 1984.

This evening Mark Horvane, who is the Director of Kyoto Garden Experiences, will provide an overview of the design principles and cultural roots of the Japanese Garden. Mark has given a similar presentation to groups in Japan and Australia. Please meet in the hotel lobby at **6:20pm**.

Please meet in the hotel lobby ready to depart at 8.00am.

Kyoto is old Japan with atmospheric temples, sublime gardens, traditional teahouses and is the heart of Japan's geisha world. It is most well known in Japanese history for being the former Imperial capital of Japan for more than one thousand years. Today we explore some of the outstanding modern works in Kyoto.

We begin with a visit to the spectacular Arashiyama Bamboo Grove, one of most photographed sights in Kyoto, followed by a stop at Kyoto Concert Hall (external view only). We then visit Shisendo Temple. Former samurai, Chinese classics scholar, and landscape architect Ishikawa Jozan built the shrine in 1641 as a retirement villa.

After lunch we visit the Kiyomizu-Dera Temple, with a spectacular view over Kyoto. We conclude the day with a visit to Nishjin Lifestyle Museum.

We return to our hotel late afternoon.

SUNDAY 12 NOVEMBER 2023

This morning we visit the Ryoan-ji Temple. Originally an aristocrat's villa during the Heian Period, the site was converted into a Zen temple in 1450 and belongs to the Myoshinji school of the Rinzai sect of Zen Buddhism. It is popular for its rock garden.

We then continue on to the famous Kinkaku Ji (Golden Pavilion), a Zen temple in northern Kyoto whose top two floors are completely covered in gold leaf.

After lunch, we will visit Katsura Imperial Villa (completed in 1645), for a guided tour of one of the finest examples of Japanese architecture and garden design. The group has been booked across different timeslots and so Wendy will advise you of your meeting time for the taxi transfer. Katsura does not allow time changes.

The museum preserves historic buildings from Japan's Meiji (1867–1912), Taisho (1912–1926), and early Shōwa (1926–1989) periods. Over 60 historical buildings have been moved and reconstructed. The most noteworthy being the main entrance and lobby of Frank Lloyd Wright's landmark Imperial Hotel, which originally stood in Tokyo from 1923 to 1967, when the main structure was demolished to make way for a new, larger version of the hotel.
